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## What to do after your walking audit

## 1. Put together a report

Now that you have completed your audit, the best thing to do is to make a short report of what you found. You can write, type or draw your report. *Be creative!* How about including photos, maps, pictures or even a video to show what you found?

Your report can be in as much or as little detail as you like. You can choose to highlight one issue, or you can choose to include lots of issues that you think need some action. Don't forget to include *your ideas* about how these issues can be improved or fixed!

This is an easy example of what your report might look like:

Number	Issue & solution or ideas	Photo
1	The footpath outside the Barker Street Retirement Village is dangerous! There are lots of trip hazards like this photo of an uneven pavement that make it very difficult for older people, people in wheelchairs to get around.  Solution: make the footpath smooth	
2	There are no seats between the Barker Street Retirement Village and the Barker Street shops. This means that it's hard for them to walk to the shops because there is nowhere to rest on the way. Some of them said they would love to have a seat with some shade so they can stop on the way to the shop or just to sit and say hello to kids walking to the primary school in the morning. Solution: put some colourful benches in and plant some trees!	

## 2. Let others know about your report
